50 Word Synopsis of Project:

Having a hearing dog makes an immense difference to the life of someone who has severely restricted hearing providing independence, confidence and valuable companionship. The dog alerts them to sounds the rest of us take for granted. In addition the presence of the dog in its distinctive burgundy coat raises public awareness of the recipient's otherwise invisible disability. Isolation is also a major problem for the hearing impaired and the companionship of the dog can be of great benefit.
