Aim

To recognise 1000 deserving individuals within our local communities with an MJF by 30 June 2018 when Lions Clubs International will be celebrating the 50th Anniversation of the Foundation.

Cost

A Melvin Jones Fellowship (MJF) may be awarded to an individual (Lion or non-Lion), or in memory of a person, for a minimum donation of US\$1,000 (currently about £650 or €900).

Comment

Since October 2010 donations to the Foundation in the general areas of Disaster Relief, Humanitarian causes (Measles, Opening Eyes Program, etc), Sight Restoration or Youth Projects (such as Quest), or Areas of Greatest Need, have qualified as a credit towards an MJF. Each month a listing of credits, called the Status of Instalments, is published by the Foundation.

## How to make an application for an MJF

First, determine if your club has sufficient credit recorded in the Status of Instalments account. To ascertain the amount of credit contact one of the following:

Before submitting the application please print and forward a copy to the LCIF MD Coordinator. Having submitted the application on-line an order acknowledgement will be forwarded to you.

Note: the lapel pin, plaque and the award letter are issued from LCIF Oak Brook, USA, and are usually received within 14 days. If more than one MJF is required then space the applications to the Foundation otherwise you will incur courier handling charges when two or more items are delivered.

If there is a shortfall in funds:

If the Status of Instalments account shows there are insufficient funds (ie less than US\$1000) or if no credits are held and it is intended to pay in full for an immediate MJF, please first contact PDG Arthur Clenton to determine exactly what funds are required, then proceed to:
